2018-19 Administrators' Compensation Report

On August 13, 2009 Governor Pat Quinn signed into law P.A. 96-0434, which created two new *School Code* provisions that require school districts to annually prepare an itemized salary compensation report for every employee holding an administrative certificate and working in that capacity.

The report must be:

- 1) presented as an information item at a regularly scheduled school board meeting;
- 2) sent to the Regional Office of Education; and
- 3) posted on the school district website **by October 1, 2018.**
