Notice to Parents/Guardians: BUS STOPS - LANARK

Some important information that we wanted to highlight for all parents prior to registration for the upcoming school year:

- Students on regular routes will receive a mailing in mid-August with information on their pick-up times.
- Grades K-6 students who reside in Lanark will be provided shuttle bus service to Shannon every morning and back to Lanark from Shannon after school. Students can access these shuttle buses in two ways:
 - OPTION 1:** From one of eight bus stops. ONLY K-6 students residing in Lanark will be allowed to use the in-town bus stops.
 - West Lanark Ave. / West Pearl St.
 - West Lanark Ave. / West Locust St.
 - West Lanark Ave. / Hanabarger
 - South School St. / East Franklin St.
 - East Lanark Ave. / East Pearl St.
 - West Claremont St. / North Boyd St. (Lanark City Park)
 - East Leland St. / North Broad St.
 - West Dame St. / North Broad St.
 - OPTION 2:** From Eastland Jr/Sr High School in Lanark. K-6 students can walk to the school, or parents can drop students off between 7:30 and 7:40 a.m. Parents dropping off students should use the north lot entrance off Broad Street. **Through traffic using the Route 64 entrance will not be allowed during this time.**

BUS STOPS - SHANNON

Grades K-6 students who reside in Shannon have access to the following bus stops:

- East Badger St. / North Linn St.
- West Badger St. / North Walnut St.
- Shannon Route / Sunset Ct.

Grades 7-12 Shannon students will be provided shuttle bus service to Lanark every morning and back to Shannon after school. Students can access the shuttle buses from the Eastland Elementary School in Shannon.

Transportation Contracts will be mailed as part of the registration packet.

HOT LUNCH PROGRAM

The Eastland School District serves breakfast and lunch on each full school day. Children may receive meals free or at a reduced price. Applications for Free and Reduced Price Lunches will be available at registration time and also at each school office after registration. If your child is not eligible by Direct Certification from the State of Illinois, you must complete an application and return it to the school.

Parents/Guardians/Students

Chromebooks/Laptops will be handed out at registration on July 20th. All 4th - 12th graders will need to attend registration with their parents to sign their Acceptable Use Policy and Laptop Home Agreement. All students, with the exception of 4th and 9th graders, will need to bring along their school provided book bag to carry their laptop home. All incoming 4th and 9th graders will be receiving new book bags and these bags will be available for them at registration. If you need to purchase a new book bag, we will have extras on hand at registration for a cost of \$35.

School Registration Information

Eastland will be holding registration for school on Thursday, July 20th from 12:00 (noon) to 7:00 p.m. in the cafeteria at Eastland Jr/Sr High School in Lanark.

Mailings will be sent to the households of all students previously enrolled in the district. Included in these mailings is a "Residency Enrollment Checklist." Public schools are required to verify the residency of students who are enrolled in their schools. This checklist must be completed by all parents/guardians for all of the students who will be enrolling in the Eastland schools for 2017-18. Students cannot register themselves. Parents/guardians should complete this form in advance, and present it first thing when they register at the high school on July 20th. With this form, you will be required to show two forms of identification from the list provided. Parents/guardians must register students, and they must have two forms of i.d. with them in order to proceed through registration.

If parents/guardians have their residency checklist and two forms of i.d. available on July 20th, it will take only a moment to verify each student's residency status. Parents/guardians will then be provided with registration packets to complete on site. We also will have a station for submitting copies of physicals or dental exams.

The last step in the process will be payment of fees. Students will be registered once all of the steps have been completed. If you are unable to complete all of the steps, or to pay fees, you will need to go back to each school before the start of the school year in order to complete the process.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation. If you did not receive a mailing, or are new or transferring to the district, please stop at any of the building offices to get copies of the information that was mailed out.

Notice to Parents / Guardians

Some important information that we wanted to highlight for all parents prior to registration for the upcoming school year:

1. School will dismiss at 3:10 on the first day of student attendance.
2. Illinois law now requires schools to identify students who might be English Language Learners. All parents/guardians of students entering pre-school or kindergarten and students new to the district will be asked at registration to complete a Home Language Survey explaining whether a language other than English is spoken in the home. This information will only be collected once. If your student lives in a home where the language spoken is other than English, the District will be conducting annual assessments of his/her English language proficiency.
3. All Eastland meal prices are increasing by .10 cents in 2017-18 due to federal mandates requiring public schools who receive reimbursement for meals to charge prices equal to the actual costs reimbursed.

Students will not be allowed to enter the Elementary building before 7:45 a.m.; the Jr/Sr High School building before 7:10 a.m. and should not linger in the buildings longer than 15 minutes after class dismissal, except for those who are requested by or under the direct supervision of a staff member.

Only on days of inclement weather will students be allowed to enter the school buildings before the scheduled times.

ALL KIDS PROGRAM

The All Kids program offers many Illinois children comprehensive healthcare that includes doctors' visits, hospital stays, prescription drugs, vision care, dental care and medical devices like eyeglasses and asthma inhalers. Some families pay monthly premiums for the coverage, but rates for middle-income families are significantly lower than they are on the private market. For instance, a family of four that earns between \$51,432 and \$78,228 a year pays a \$40 monthly premium per child, and a \$10 co-pay per physician visit. Fill out the application today.

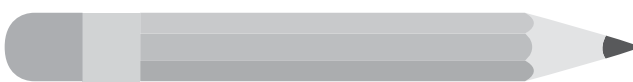
