## School Registration Information

Eastland will be holding registration for school on Wednesday, July 28th, from 12:00 (noon) to 7:00 p.m. in the new cafeteria at Eastland Middle School in Lanark. All registration will be at the Middle School this year due to the construction at Eastland High School.

Mailings were sent to the households of all students previously enrolled in the district. Included in these mailings was a "Residency Enrollment Checklist." Public schools are required to verify the residency of students who are enrolled in their schools. This checklist must be completed by all parents/guardians for all of the students who will be enrolling in the Eastland schools for 2010-11. Students cannot register themselves. Parents/guardians should complete this form in advance, and present it first thing when they register at the middle school on July 28th. With this form, you will be required to show two forms of identification from the list provided. Parents/guardians must register students, and they must have two forms of i.d. with them in order to proceed through registration.

Also included in the mailing is a "Certificate of Residence" form that must be completed only for students who are:

1. new or transferring to the district, or
2. living with another adult who is not their parent, or
3. homeless

If parents/guardians have their residency checklist and two forms of i.d. available on July 28th, it will take only a moment to verify each student(s)' residency status. Parents/guardians will then be provided with registration packets to complete on site. We also will have a station for submitting copies of physicals or dental exams.

The last step in the process will be payment of fees. Students will be registered once all of the steps have been completed. If you are unable to complete all of the steps, or to pay fees, you will need to go back to each school before the start of the school year in order to complete the process.

We appreciate your patience and cooperation. If you did not receive a mailing, or are new or transferring to the district, please stop at any of the building offices to get copies of the information that was mailed out.

## Notice to Parents / Guardians

Some important information that we wanted to highlight for all parents prior to registration for the upcoming school year:

Again this year, 1st and 2nd grade students will be eligible to participate in a voluntary, after-school Spanish program at Eastland Elementary. 1st graders will meet two days per week, and 2nd graders two days per week, from 2:30-3:15. Although this will not start until after Labor Day, we will be asking parents of 1st and 2nd graders to enroll their children in the program at registration, so materials can be ordered, and transportation routes prepared. The program is of no additional cost to parents.

When considering whether to participate in this voluntary program, please remember that all students will be required to take Spanish during the school day starting in 3rd grade.

Dismissals during the first week of student attendance (August 23-27) will be as follows:

- Eastland Elementary – 1:30 p.m.
- Eastland Middle and High School – 2:10 p.m.

Schedules will be adjusted to reduce any instructional time that might be lost, and teachers and administrators will use the remaining time for staff development. Beginning on Monday, August 30th, we will return to our regular dismissal times of 2:30 at Eastland Elementary, and 3:10 at Eastland Middle and High School.

Illinois law now requires schools to identify students who might be English Language Learners. All parents/guardians will be asked at registration this year to complete a Home Language Survey explaining whether a language other than English is spoken in the home. This information will only be collected once. If your student does live in a home where the language spoken is other than English, the District will be conducting annual assessments of his/her English language proficiency.

## Shuttle Bus Schedules

Starting this year, shuttle buses leaving Eastland Elementary and Eastland Middle School daily will depart promptly at 7:45. In the past, buses have left at 7:50. By leaving at 7:45, students will lose less instructional time. This will also give us extra time to transport students on days when roads are snow-packed.

Bus routes will be changed to accommodate this change. Parents/guardians of students who walk to the shuttles, or who drop students off to catch a shuttle, should plan accordingly. Students who are using the shuttle buses should arrive at Eastland Elementary or Eastland Middle School no earlier than 7:30 a.m. Adult supervisors will not be on site prior to 7:30 each morning.

## Hot Lunch Program

The Eastland School District serves breakfast and lunch on each full school day. Children may receive meals free or at a reduced price. Applications for Free and Reduced Price Lunches will be available at registration time and also at each school office after registration. To receive free or reduced price meals for your child(ren), you must either complete an application and return it to the school or present an eligibility certificate to the school.

## Kid Care Program

KidCare is a State of Illinois program that offers healthcare to families who are not able to provide insurance for their children and for pregnant women. KidCare provides cash rebates to families who may have health insurance and fall within certain income guidelines. If you are interested and would like an application, or if you have more questions about the program, please feel free to contact the school.

## Freshman and New Student (Grades 9-12) Orientation

All freshmen and new students grades 9-12 are encouraged to attend. There will be a shuttle bus leaving the Middle school at 1:45 and returning at 3:15. Lanark students are responsible for their own transportation to orientation. The guidance counselor will be available to answer questions about your schedule. You will meet your teachers, tour the school, and find your lockers. If you want to, you can bring your school supplies.

## Season Passes

Season passes for athletic events in the Eastland School District will be available in each of the school offices. The cost of the season pass for an adult is \$50 and for students \$32. Family passes for athletic events are available at a cost of \$125 per family. Applications for family passes may be obtained from any of the school offices. Eastland School District season passes will be honored at Pearl City football games.

## Senior Citizen Passes

Residents who are 65 years or older may obtain permanent complimentary passes to all home athletic events, excluding tournaments and playoffs. Please contact the district office to obtain a complimentary pass.

## Required Physicals

All school physicals are due on the first day of school. The School Code of Illinois requires preschool, kindergarten, sixth, and ninth grade students to have a physical. Immunizations must be up to date with state requirements. Students lacking required information will be excluded from school on Sept. 15.

All students participating in any interscholastic sports or cheerleading are expected to have completed similar examinations before the first practice. Forms for this purpose may be secured from any school office.

K, 2, and 6 grades are required to have dental exams.

K students are required to have a vision exam.

K, 6, 9 students are required to have diabetes screening on their physicals.

## Student Insurance

Student insurance is available at a nominal cost and is optional. When a student insured under this plan is injured, he/she will be given a claim form from the office.
